Please join us for a Slide Show and discussion of Carol's process of painting at our next general meeting.

"Having grown up in Florida, my strongest visual impression of an environment for human activity is water. In much of my work, water, either literal or suggested, provides the setting for anonymous figures. Because the figures are abstracted, they become generic; their generic nature allows for expansion of the narrative beyond a personal, anecdotal statement to portray a more universal human condition.

The paintings contain duality: clarity and ambiguity; sanctuary and threat; pleasure and pain. The use of vibrant, saturated colors--beautiful, but confrontational in their intensity--contributes to the tension between these extremes. The large scale of the watercolor and acrylic pieces is also confrontational. The resulting images are seductive, powerful, and strangely disquieting.

For me, painting should have an intimacy, a mysteriousness, a sensuality. At its best, my work also has an edge; something in it that takes a moment, a second look, an effort to comprehend."

This is to notify you that the following proposed amendment to the SAWG Constitution will be presented and voted on, providing a quorum is established, at the April 11, 2006 SAWG Annual Meeting and Guest Artist Presentation at the Windmill Inn, 4250 N. Campbell Ave, 6:30pm - 9:00pm.

For years, there has been much confusion and no clear justification for the waiting time between when new "active" members are selected by jury in March and when their new status becomes effective in June – a lapse of almost 3 months. To correct this, we ask that all SAWG members, especially those with voting rights (current "active 1 and 2", "Signature" and "Honorary") attend and vote to change SAWG Constitution Section 2-2 Election of Members, Beginning with:

"The Jury will meet and make such judgments in March of each year, new Memberships becoming effective as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, the start of the fiscal year."  
 To: "The Jury will meet and make such judgments in March of each year, new Memberships becoming effective immediately following the Jury's decision, beginning with 2006."
